ECC-REPORT Cathy Ortel

Happy Summer Everyone!

To the many homeowners who keep their places looking great, we thank you! To the homeowners who think the rules don't apply to them, you have received a second notice with a compliance date of July 30th. Our original notice requested the work be done or a reply received by the end of June.

The "Blue Book" states that homes are supposed to be maintained year round. Getting around to the required repairs in September is not acceptable. If you don't want to keep up this type of property, it's a great time to sell! Most of us take great pride in our community and thousands of hours are spent by this committee and the Board of Directors and other volunteers in trying to maintain our property values. Remember, this is why you bought in this community to begin with. You fell in love with how great it looked and how safe it was for your fam-

ily. Now, we ask your cooperation in maintaining what you fell in love with. This includes keeping up with the weeds which are having a great season and require constant attention this time of year.

Another inspection will be done the week of August 5th. If we have not received a response or the work has not been completed, we will begin the process of setting up hearings and a possible fine.

We are receiving several complaints about "loud" electric colors being used on decks, roofs, etc. It has been our policy in the past to not need approval if the color being used is going from one shade of blue, etc. to another. Now that we have this issue, this policy is undergoing change. Any change to the existing color that is brighter or a different shade will require an ECC approval form along with a color swatch of the proposed new color. We have received requests for orange doors, tri colored steps,

etc. The reason our community does not look like a circus of colors is due to a consistent neutral look. This look will be maintained. If a loud or neon color is applied without prior approval, further action will be taken.

Please remember that all roof vents are to be black, brown, gray or white. Blue, red, green etc. are not approved colors. If you have any questions regarding this issue, please feel free to email us at CEO.Assateague@Yahoo.com.
