ECC NEWS UPDATE-Cathy Ortel and ECC Committee

Dear Neighbors,

Thank you so much for a great Spring response! The Pointe is looking terrific this year and the committee appreciates all the time and effort everyone is putting into their homes.

One of our biggest issues this year is aging screens. If they are original they are breaking down and are difficult to power wash and most have holes. If you cannot repair them yourself, Elliott's Hardware does provide this service. In addition, a list of contractors is available at the front office who can also do the work.

Original exterior lights are also breaking and brittle and may also require replacement very soon.

Air conditioners being replaced need to be re-skirted. Lattice is acceptable in place of skirting around the units stand. It may be painted to match the skirting if the original skirting is other than white. Gray skirt may have gray lattice, yellow skirting may have yellow lattice, etc. Painted lattice needs to be as close as possible to the original color of the skirting.
