### APRIL 23, 2011 AT NOON IN THE CLUBHOUSE

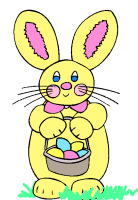
Sign up at the office for the annual Easter Egg Coloring at Noon and the Hunt to follow.
