If you have any questions, or are aware of anything that needs attention, please let us know by informing Valerie at the front office and we will look into it.



HVAC Replacements at Assateague Pointe

Recently there have been a lot of HVAC replacements in Assateague Pointe and below is a reminder of guidelines that should be followed.

- 1) No approval is required to replace your HVAC unit unless the unit is moved to a different location
- 2) All replacement units should be skirted and bordered.
- 3) New FEMA guidelines require all units to be at base flood elevation or at least the height of the 1st floor of your home.
- 4) Placement of the new unit must not encroach on your neighbor's property.

The ECC is in the process of doing their Spring inspections so please try to adhere to the above to avoid a violation letter.
