The Board is sorry for any problems this may have caused. We had to replace the concrete around the pool area at the rec center this year due to settlement in the existing concrete. The new gate system is in and running as well as the two new cameras at the front gate. Remember the cards cannot be reused within ten minutes of using the card, if you have a guest in another vehicle have them sign in and get a pass, this will make it easier on you and our staff because they will see the pass and let them in. So don't turn your card in because it did not work, it is doing what we programmed it to do. We have already contacted Homeowners who have lifted the gate to let cars thru and tried passing the card back first. The computer tells what time you came in and how many times you tried using your card. Another good reason we went to this system, is when someone sells their home here at the Pointe we can deactivate their cards, in the long run this will save us money by not having to change the systems every 3 to 4 years at a cost of around \$5,000.

Please remember to spruce up around the outside of your homes, the ECC committee has done their inspection and have sent violations to Homeowners. Pleas take time to address these issues, this is what makes Assateague Pointe a great place to live. Thank all of you who take pride in your homes and keep them in great shape.

The annual meeting this year has been moved up a week to July 8TH make sure you mark your calendars and come out to meeting, it is informative, the election of your Board is held at this time, committee reports as well as the finicial report.


