We are happy to say that all Spring inspections have been completed. Thank you to all the homeowners who have done a great job at the beginning of the season. The community is looking great this year, in fact, better than it's ever looked! If you have received a notice July 8th is the deadline for all repairs and correspondence before we begin the second round. As always, if you have a problem completing the work by that time PLEASE RESPOND IN WRITING AND MAIL OR FAX THE FORM TO THE FRONT OFFICE. DO NOT CALL THE FRONT OFFICE SINCE ALL RESPONSES NEED TO BE IN WRITING FOR DOCUMENTATION PURPOSES.

In an effort to save the community money we do not normally send out a notice for just power washing unless there is an area that is extremely bad. The same goes for weeds which everyone has to some degree since it has been another wet spring unless they are also bad. Our biggest problem this year seems to be the black mold on the concrete, Power washing without the use of some type of cleaner is making a streaky mess. Mold Armour makes a product for siding and concrete which is available at Home Depot and Lowes and there are many other products on the market.

Please look up as you are walking around your property since we have a lot of roof vents that need attention. The approved colors for the vents are black, brown, gray or white. No funny colors please! If you are changing any exterior colors on anything else please remember to attach a swatch to your ECC application so we can get you approved faster
