An inventory of broken furniture has been taken and presented to the board for replacement for next year. The Rec Center pool also has been covered for the winter.

The clubhouse pool construction has begun. As of this date the pool has been drained, tile and plaster has been removed and the soft spots in the pool bottom are being worked on. The old skimmers have been torn out and the new ones are now in place. We wanted to install a ramp on the south side of the clubhouse pool but we do not have enough room for a ramp according to the county. So we are not able to install a ramp. We are looking into longer railings for the entrances into the pool as well as a handicapped lift. The drainage system for the pool deck will also be replaced. When all the work has been completed a cover will be placed on the clubhouse pool as well. At this time all the work is on time and to be completed by the beginning of November.
