If you have sold or purchased a new golf cart, please notify the office so they can update the records on file. Remember to complete an ECC form for any exterior changes.

No WOOD-BURNING FIRE PITS ARE ALLOWED. With the cooler summer evenings that we have been having, please remember no wood fire pits. You may have propane fire pits.

# Storage Yard- Joyce Wetzel

I want to thank everyone for their cooperation in spraying for weeds in the Storage Yard. We still have a ways to go to "spiffy" things up so take a look around your slot and if you have trash lying around, pick it up, or if you have smaller items that have been stacked in the back of your slot and they are in disrepair or no longer needed, fix them or toss them. Also, if you witness anyone throwing stuff in the any of the dumpsters and missing their target, if they don't pick it up, say something to them. 
